If your family is experiencing genuine hardship, please reach out to us confidentially — we're here to support you. We never want a child to miss school because they don't have food.

Finally, a reminder about the importance of arriving on time. The school day begins at 8:25am, and arriving late means students miss out on crucial learning at the start of the day. Please also note that there is no supervision provided before 8:25am, so we ask that students are not dropped off early.
